

Minutes of the special meeting of the City Council of the City of Huntington Park held Monday, October 10, 2005.

The meeting was called to order in the Council Conference Room at 5:00 p.m. by Mayor Hernandez. Present: Council Member Juan R. Noguez, Vice Mayor Elba Guerrero, Council Member Elba Romo, and Mayor Ofelia Hernandez. Absent: Council Member Mario Gomez.

Mayor Hernandez opened oral communications, indicating that this was the time for anyone in the audience to address the City Council on any matter of City business and hearing none, declared oral communications closed.

City Clerk Ramirez announced that in accordance with published notice, this is the time and place set to consider public comment regarding extending the time period of extending Urgency Interim Zoning Ordinance No. 741-NS which places a moratorium on the alteration or destruction of architectural significant commercial properties located in the City of Huntington Park. The City Clerk reported that no written communications had been received in the Office of the City Clerk. Mayor Hernandez declared the public hearing open and called for oral communications and hearing none, Mayor Hernandez declared the public hearing closed.

ORDINANCE NO. 764-NS. AN URGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON PARK EXTENDING URGENCY INTERIM ORDINANCE NO. 738-NS WHICH PLACED A MORATORIUM ON THE ALTERATION OR DESTRUCTION OF ARCHITECTURAL SIGNIFICANT COMMERCIAL PROPERTIES LOCATED IN THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON PARK was read by title. Motion by Noguez, seconded by Romo, that reading in full of Urgency Ordinance No. 764-NS for first and final reading be waived; and that Urgency Ordinance No. 764-NS be introduced and approved for first and final reading and adopted, carried as follows: Ayes: Council Member Noguez, Vice Mayor Guerrero, Council Member Romo, and Mayor Hernandez; Noes: None; Absent: Council Member Gomez.
