

Minutes of the special meeting of the City Council of the City of Huntington Park held Monday, November 16, 2009.

The meeting was called to order in the Council Chambers at 5:43 p.m. by Mayor Gomez. Present: Council Member Ofelia Hernandez, Vice Mayor Juan R. Noguez, Council Member Elba Guerrero, Council Member Andy Molina, and Mayor Mario Gomez. Absent: None.

City Clerk Ramirez announced that the special meeting was called for the purpose of conducting a study session with State Assembly Member John A. Perez to discuss the State of California Budget and issues that affect the City of Huntington Park.

Mayor Gomez opened oral communications, indicating that this was the time for anyone in the audience to address the City Council on any matter of City business, and hearing none, declared oral communications closed.

State Assembly Member John A. Perez informed City Council of his work on behalf of the constituents of the City of Huntington Park including various Assembly Bills that he was

successful in getting passed. Mr. Perez also stated that the State is facing its greatest economic challenge and that it is essential to keep projects moving to help the economy. Mr. Perez asked that people be thoughtful when voting on bond measures.

Mayor Gomez and City Council presented State Assembly Member John A. Perez with a City pin and expressed their gratitude for all his efforts and representing the City well.

Mayor Gomez declared the meeting adjourned at 6:12 p.m.
