

**Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the City of Huntington Park  
Health and Education Commission  
held March 23, 2010**

***MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING HELD ON FEBRUARY 23, 2010:***

A motion was made by Commissioner Murillo, seconded by Herrera, to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held February 23, 2010. The motion carried as follows: Ayes: Commissioners Savage, Herrera and Murillo; Noes: None; Absent: Commissioners Flores and Zaldivar-Motts.

***NEW BUSINESS:***

***A. Reorganization of the Commission:***

Chairperson Savage vacated her position as Chairperson.

Vice Chair Zaldivar-Motts called for nominations for Chairman.

A motion was made by Commissioner Herrera, seconded by Commissioner Savage, to nominate Commissioner Zaldivar-Motts as Chairman. The motion was unanimously approved.

A motion was made by Commissioner Murillo, seconded by Commissioner Flores, to nominate Commissioner Savage as Vice Chair. The motion was unanimously approved.

***B. Discussion and/or action to participate and co-sponsor "Soccer in the Streets and Health Fair", on Sunday, April 18, 2010:***

Present to address the Commission was Ivette Flores Guintu, Program Manager for USC Institute for Global Health. Ms. Guintu stated that USC is hosting the "Soccer in the Streets and Health Fair" on April 18, 2010 at Salt Lake Park from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. Ms. Guintu requested that the HEC partner with USC to maximize the event. Commissioner Savage requested flyers from City staff to promote the Census at this event.

A motion was made by Herrera, seconded by Murillo, to sponsor the USC Institute for Global Health "Soccer in the Streets and Health Fair" on April 18, 2010 at Salt Lake Park from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. along with the HEC's attendance at the event. The motion was unanimously approved.

*C. Discussion and/or action on a list of goals and objectives for the HEC in 2010:*

Commissioner Savage informed the Commission of the topics that were discussed at the All American City Award committee meeting:

- Lead paint removal
- Child obesity
- Healthier Huntington Park residents

A motion was made by Herrera, seconded by Flores, to participate in the All American City Award committee in relation to programs that are related to child obesity.

Commissioner Flores stated that Walgreens has a mobile unit that they utilize for flu shots as well as distributing the H1N1 shots and that this would be helpful for the Health Fair in October.

Commissioner Savage stated that she would coordinate the Children's Fair on April 18.

Commissioner Herrera stated that she would coordinate the "Relay for life" scheduled for June 19 and 20, 2010.


Commissioner Flores stated that he would coordinate the Senior Health Fair.
