It encourages cities to create programs and policies that promote physical activity and good nutrition. A motion was made by Savage, seconded by Herrera, to direct staff to prepare a report to the City Council to adopt a resolution declaring the City of Huntington Park a Healthy Eating, Active Living (HEAL) City. 
*B. Discussion and/or action on the All-America City Award:*
