IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL:

1. Upon Council approval, direct staff to proceed with purchase and installation of hardscape for Pacific Boulevard Pedestrian Improvement Project along Pacific Boulevard; and
2. Authorize additional budget appropriation of \$717,658.

PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION

On October 3, 2017 staff provided a report to Council of options and estimated costs in order to proceed with implementation of the remaining scope of work for Pacific Boulevard Pedestrian Improvement Project. Below is the remaining scope of work and the total estimated costs:
