A Phased Approach to Reopen Safely

California, counties, local governments may have their independent guidelines. Please adhere to the following if your business is within Huntington Park, California. This document provides goalposts for reopening safely.

Five-Stage Reopening Process Based On Risk

STAGE 1

Until
May 31st

Safety and Preparedness

- Safer at Home Order (still in place) - **Essential business only**
- Planning and Recovery (in the process)

STAGE 2

Begins
June 1st

Curbside
Pick-up
Only
(The act of
picking up an online
or phone purchase
without stepping
out of your car)

Lower-Risk Workplaces (Ensure distancing and infection control for all categories.)

- **Florists & toy, book, clothing** (Shoes, Bridal, Boutique, Quinceanera), **music, sporting goods stores** (Cycling, Soccer, Skate Shops)
- **Car Dealership Showrooms** - Modifications to ensure distancing and infection control
- **Other low-risk businesses** (manufacturers, offices, retail, jewelry, logistics, dine-in restaurants, shopping malls, furniture, beauty care)
- **Essential health care**
- **Outdoor recreation and libraries**
- **Cultural centers**

STAGE 3

Higher-Risk Workplace

- Higher-risk businesses (hair salon, nail salons, body art/tattoo shops, massage, bars/nightclubs, gyms, portrait studios)
- Movie theatres and bowling alleys
- K-12 Schools
- Colleges and universities
- Churches

STAGE 4

Large Higher-Risk Workplace

- Higher-risk businesses (entertainment venues)
- Sporting and spectator events

STAGE 5

End of Stay at Home

- Fully normal operations

Five Key areas to focus on before reopening a business

1. Workplace policies and practices to protect employee health
2. Measure to ensure physical distancing
3. Measure to ensure infection control
4. Communication with employees and the public
5. Measure to ensure equitable access to critical services
