

PROJECT BUDGET & FUNDING

- **Total Project Cost = \$750K**
 - \$668K construction + \$82K engineering/construction management
- **Funding Sources**
 - City of Vernon (\$125K + \$500K = \$625K)
 - City of Huntington Park (\$125K)
- **City of Vernon - Good Neighbor Program**
 - Environmental and Community Benefit Fund
 - Funding for regional community recreational facilities

Items too large, bulky or heavy for normal trash collection will be picked up for free.

- Furniture
- Air conditioners
- Bicycles
- Monitors
- Mattresses
- Scrap wood
- Televisions
- Keyboards
- Refrigerators
- Metal
- Computers
- Printers

Please no hazardous materials, such as paints, motor oil, solvents, car batteries, anti-freeze, etc. Items must weigh less than 150 pounds (except appliances) and not require more than two people to handle.

- Pick-up days will be on **Saturdays** from 7 a.m. to noon.
- Place everything on the curb by 6 a.m. in order to guarantee pick-up.
- No alley pick-ups.
