City's Senior Lunch Program Wins \$20,000!

**¡Huntington Park gana una subvención de \$20,000
del programa Match Grant de AltaMed!**

Early this spring, the City of Huntington Park won AltaMed's Grow Together Match Program as part of the Elevate SELA campaign! Out of the nineteen entries submitted, Huntington Park's Senior Lunch Wellness Program which provides healthy meals to senior citizens, promotes healthy eating habits and encourages a friendly environment to reduce social isolation, won the grant!

The grant will provide more healthy meals to senior citizens. Prior to the award seniors could only participate in the Senior Lunch Wellness Program three times a week. Now, with the support of the match grant the City can provide a healthy meal five times a week, which will alleviate the financial stressors associated with securing their own meals.

Ahora, con el apoyo de AltaMed, la ciudad puede proporcionar alimentos saludables cinco veces a la semana, lo que aliviará el estrés financiero para nuestros residentes mayores.

CELEBRANDO EL DIA DE LA TIERRA

The City of Huntington Park hosted its 2nd Annual Earth Day Event last April where it introduced new green initiatives, hosted a tree-planting ceremony and cleaned-up the community!

With the generous help of CalRecycle, Huntington Park recently installed 34 Big Belly solar-powered waste/recycling bins in strategic locations along the commercial corridors of Pacific Boulevard. In addition to keeping the city clean, Big Bellies are economical and beneficial for the environment. The solar-powered compactors prevent overflow of litter and provide five times the volume of a regular bins.

At the event, volunteers spread the word about the City's MyHuntingtonPark App where residents can now report illegal dumping and graffiti.

La ciudad de Huntington Park organizó su segundo evento anual celebrando el Día de la Tierra el pasado mes de abril, donde presentó nuevas iniciativas ecológicas, plantaron árboles y limpiaron la comunidad!

Con la generosa ayuda de CalRecycle, Huntington Park ha instalado treinta y cuatro contenedores de reciclaje que utilizan de energía solar, los Big Belly se ubican en posiciones estratégicas a lo largo de los corredores comerciales del bulevar Pacific. Además de mantener la ciudad limpia, los Big Belly ahorran dinero y ayudan a el medio ambiente. Los compactadores solares impiden el desbordamiento de basura y proporcionan cinco veces más volumen que los contenedores normales.

En el evento, los voluntarios también informaron a los residentes sobre la aplicación móvil de la ciudad, MyHuntingtonPark, en cual los residentes pueden denunciar basura que se ha dejado ilegalmente en áreas publicas y ademas el grafiti.

Mini-Spartans Robotics team are making the City of Huntington Park proud! The team is made up of a group of 6 amazingly talented, creative, and hardworking students from Miles STEM Magnet. Since October, these students have devoted countless hours building, programming and driving a robot while developing a comprehensive STEM Research Project-- all of this is in addition to their regular classwork.

In February, the Mini-Spartans took first place in the STEM Research Project and ranked seventh in the challenge competition at the 2018 California VEX IQ Elementary School State Championship - Southern California!

This accomplishment qualified them to the World Championship in Kentucky. In April, the Mini-Spartan Robotics Team competed against students from Japan, China, Egypt, Japan at a "VexWorlds" Robotics Competition. Their hard work and dedication paid off as they ranked in the top 10% in the world!

Detective Fuentes and K-9 Kaz completed the intense training program at Adlerhorst Narcotics Detection School.

Both Detective Fuentes and Kaz have been awarded their Certificate of Completion, and were recognized as the top K-9 in their class. When Kaz isn't working hard in the city, she loves playing fetch and getting hugs!

¡El equipo de robótica Mini-Spartan de Miles Elementary es uno de los mejores en el Mundo!

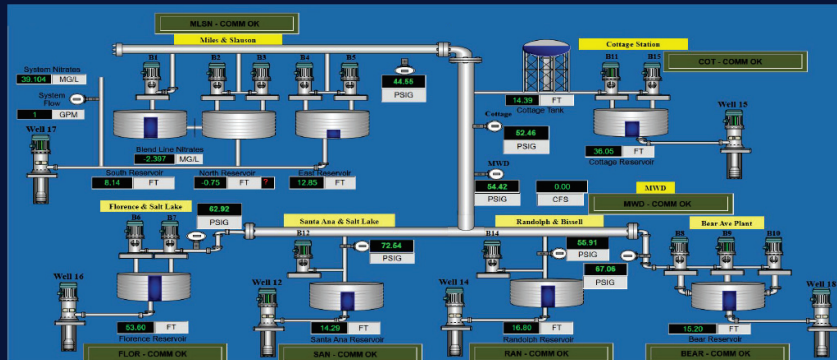

Desde octubre, los estudiantes han dedicado innumerables horas a la construcción, programación y conducción de un robot mientras desarrollan un proyecto integral de investigación STEM, todo esto además de su tarea.

Los Mini-Spartans obtuvieron el primer lugar en el Proyecto de Investigación STEM y ocuparon el séptimo lugar en la competencia de desafío en el Campeonato Estatal de Escuelas Primarias de California VEX IQ 2018: Del Sur de California.

Este logro los calificó para el Campeonato Mundial en Kentucky. En abril, el equipo compitió contra estudiantes de Japón, China, Egipto y Panamá en la competencia de robótica "VexWorlds." ¡Su arduo trabajo y dedicación dieron sus frutos ya que el equipo superó a 90% de los otros equipos!

A SCADA is crucial for the City's operation since it helps maintain efficiency, processes data for better decision making, and communicate system issues to help mitigate downtime.
