B. PREVIOUS ITEMS

1. All residents/business owners were notified via phone of the Traffic Authority (TA) results of their agenda item/request from the October 4, 2018 meeting.

C. NEW ITEMS

1. 6035 Pacific Blvd. Request for Reinstatement of an Uncontrolled Crosswalk on Pacific Boulevard between Belgrave Avenue and Randolph Street.
2. 2438 E. 55th Street. Request for 30-min Green Curb.

D. UPDATES

1. 6613 Plaska Avenue. Request to add speed cushions to reduce speeding. The application was denied and signage enhancement as well as routine enforcement was recommended. The applicant has been informed.
2. 6625 Arbutus Avenue. Speed humps request for the entire block. The application was denied and signage enhancement as well as routine enforcement was recommended. The applicant has been informed.
3. Request to revise hours of Permit Parking at the City Hall parking lot located at 6550 Miles Avenue.
 - Traffic Engineer submitted designs of signs with towed-away provision and posting locations for TA to consider.
4. Aspire Pacific Academy, 2565 E. 58th Street. Request to make alley south of the school into a one-way alley. Coordination with school administrators and inform them of the TA decision denying their request.
 - The school administrators have been contacted and informed of the TA

- decision denying their request.
- Established Work Order No. 18-00830 for four traffic signs to be posted at the south alley. Completed on October 11, 2018.
- 5. Vehicle and pedestrian traffic concerns at Linda Esperanza Marquez High School, 6361 Cottage Street. Updated report.
 - The Traffic Engineer submitted a “Service Request” to LA County Department of Public Works to review and address the concerns.
 - The Traffic Engineer submitted draft plans to implement no parking and no U-turn on Cottage Avenue near the entrance to the school.
 - City Manager to discuss with City Council.
- 8. Non-Functioning Rectangular Rapid-Flashing Beacons (RRFBs) and corresponding Pedestrian Push Button (PPBs) units at Uncontrolled Marked Crosswalks.
 - Established Work Order No. 18-00831 for removal and salvage of the existing non-functional RRFBs and corresponding PPBs units per approval by the Traffic Authority at the October 4, 2018 meeting.
