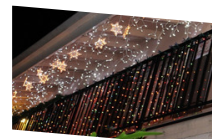
2018 Mayor's Holiday Award

Various Street Improvement Project CIP 2018-19

The purpose of the Various Street Improvement Project is to enhance the deteriorating pavement conditions, lengthen the life cycle and minimize routine maintenance. The pavement resurfacing and full reconstruction infrastructure project across the city will repair structural deficiencies. The project includes adjusting all affected utility manholes and valve covers to grade, traffic striping, and traffic control to ensure vehicular and pedestrian safety.
