In efforts of bringing new services to the community on April 11th, Huntington Park hosted the very first H.P Senior Pantry Program alongside LA Food Bank. It was a total success with 160 seniors joining to receive their FREE food kit.



The Los Angeles Regional Food Bank, whose mission it is to mobilize resources to fight hunger in our community, is committed to working with community partners, donors and volunteers to provide food assistance for the one in eight people struggling with food insecurity in Los Angeles County. They are well-equipped to serve children and our growing population of older adults, who often have to make hard choices about whether to buy food or medicine.

The food kit contains cereal, milk, juice, peanut butter, grains, canned meat, vegetables, fruit and a block of cheese. We invite all seniors over the age of 60 to bring a photo ID and join us **May 30th from 9a-11a** to the next H.P Senior Pantry Program at the Community Center. 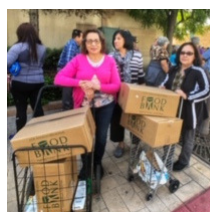

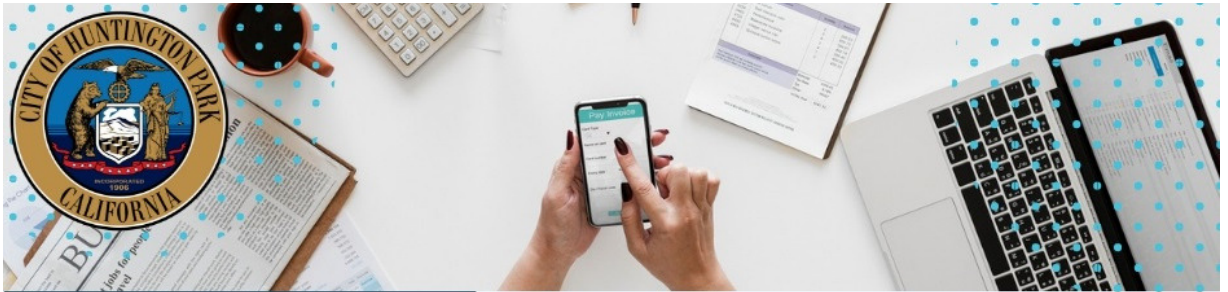

If your pet is Spayed or Neutered, include a copy of the Certificate of Sterilization for the animal.

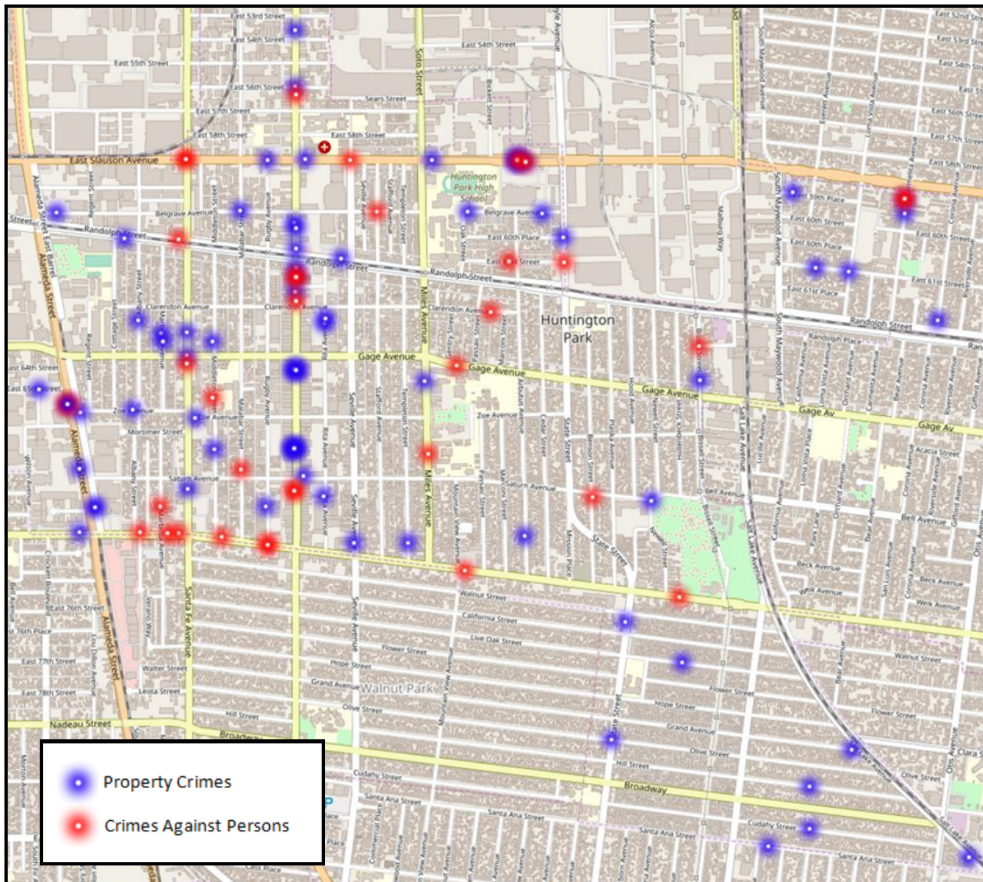

100 year Anniversary

"The Childrens Tribute to the World War Heroes"

Everyone has seen the "Little Bronze Girl" statue located at Keller Park City Hall. Wonder what the statue represents and how it got to there?

The real name of the memorial is "The Children's Tribute to the World War Heroes"

The statue is a memorial for all the soldiers and sailors from Huntington Park who served in WWI. The little girl is pressing to her heart a cap of a sailor on one hand and of a soldier on the other.

The statue was a community effort! Huntington Park residents fund-raised to gather funds in 1919 "To Honor Our Boys" was the slogan they used. It initially was a fountain and later changed to what it is today for safety purposes.

FunFact! The "Little Bronze Girl" was a Huntington Park resident named Francis Parker. She earned 10 cents an hour to pose for this sculpture. Sculptor-Burt W. Johnson.



The plaque reads as follows, "This memorial has erected by the people of Huntington Park in the year 1919 and dedicated by them to Huntington Park men who died or offered to die for world freedom in the war 1914-1918. He who offered his life in noble purpose is heroic. Though he live. He who dies that others may live better is divine."

100 años del aniversario

"El tributo de los niños a los héroes de la guerra mundial"

Todos han visto la estatua de la "Nina de Bronce" ubicada en Keller Park en el City Hall. Se pregunta qué representa la estatua y cómo llegó.

El nombre real del memorial es "El tributo de los niños a los héroes de la guerra mundial"

La estatua es un monumento para todos los soldados y marineros de Huntington Park que sirvieron en la Primera Guerra Mundial. La niña está presionando a su corazón una gorra de un marinero en una mano y de un soldado en la otra.

¡La estatua fue un esfuerzo comunitario! Los residentes de Huntington Park recaudaron fondos en 1919 para poder inaugurar tan lindo monumento. Inicialmente fue una fuente y luego se cambió a lo que es hoy por motivos de seguridad.

¡Dato divertido! La "Niña de Bronce" era residente de Huntington Park llamada Francis Parker. Ella ganó 10 centavos por hora para posar para esta escultura. Escultor Burt W. Johnson.

La placa dice lo siguiente: "Este monumento ha sido erigido por la gente de Huntington Park en el año 1919 y dedicado por ellos a los hombres de Huntington Park que murieron o se ofrecieron a morir por la libertad mundial en la guerra 1914-1918. El que ofreció su vida en noble propósito es heroico. Aunque viva. El que muere para que otros puedan vivir mejor es divino."

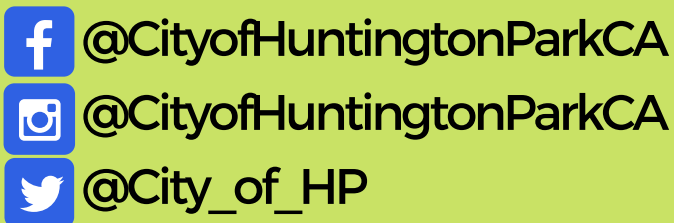
