FERIA DE LA SALUD 2023



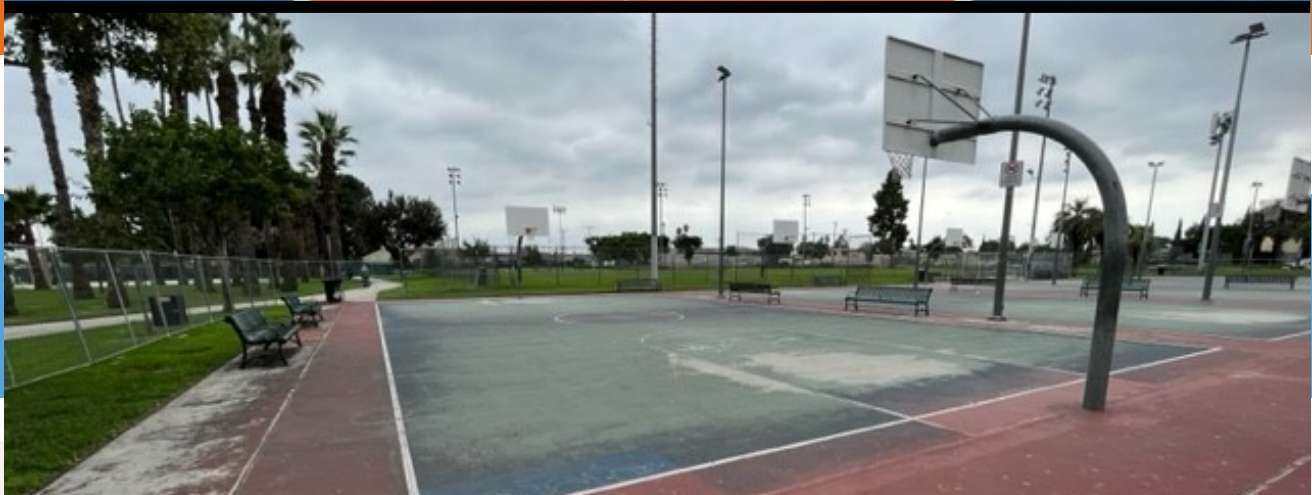
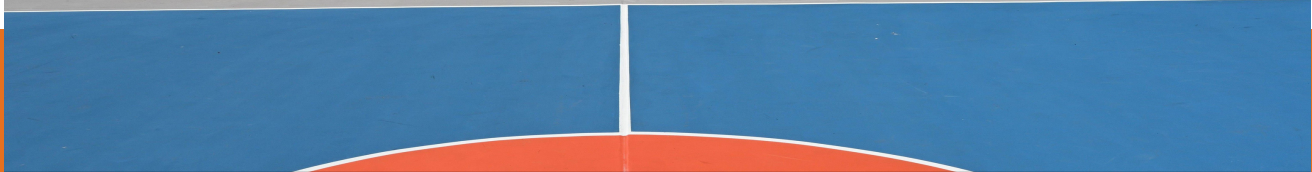

On Wednesday, September 27, 2023, the Fair Housing Foundation held a workshop at the Salt Lake Park Recreation Center. This workshop hosted city residents and property owners that learned about their housing rights and responsibilities. The presentation provided information on COVID-19, New Statewide laws, Federal and State Fair Housing Laws, Housing Discrimination, Modifications & Accommodation, Families with Children, Notices, Evictions Process, Security Deposits, Habitability & Repairs, Rent Increases, and other housing related topics that helped the attendees to learn about their housing rights.
