
Message from the City Manager

HUNTINGTON PARK - AVAILABLE HOUSING PROGRAMS

The City offers various programs for Huntington Park residents funded by Community Development Block Grant and HOME Investment Partnerships Program by the US Department of Housing and Urban Development. Currently, the City offers 3 programs listed below:

The Emergency Rental Assistance Program is open for low-income residents that were impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic to help with up to 3 months of rental assistance. The City has dedicated \$500,000 for rental assistance for the Fiscal Year 23-24. The program is funded through the Department of Housing and Urban Development's Community Development Block Grant program and CARES Act.

The Home Repair Program will provide financial assistance to eligible Huntington Park homeowners in the form of a grant no greater than \$25,000 per single family residential unit. Tenant-occupied units are not eligible for assistance. Funding for the program includes all labor, equipment, supplies/materials necessary for the repairs.

The First Time Homebuyer Program can help with downpayment and closing costs assistance to help low income Huntington Park households buy their first home. The City can invest up to \$120,000 or 20% in downpayment assistance. The property must be located within the City limits. Applicant must be a first-time home buyer currently residing in Huntington Park and must occupy the property as a principal residence.

El Programa de asistencia de alquiler de emergencia está abierto para los residentes de bajos ingresos que se vieron afectados por la pandemia de COVID-19 para ayudar con hasta 3 meses de asistencia de alquiler. La Ciudad ha dedicado \$500,000 para asistencia de alquiler para el año fiscal 22-23. El programa está financiado a través del programa CDBG del Departamento de Vivienda y Desarrollo Urbano y la Ley CARES.

El Programa de reparación de viviendas brindará asistencia financiera a los propietarios de viviendas elegibles de Huntington Park en forma de una subvención de no más de \$25,000 por unidad residencial unifamiliar. Las unidades ocupadas por inquilinos no son elegibles para recibir asistencia. La financiación del programa incluye toda la mano de obra, equipos, suministros/materiales necesarios para las reparaciones.

La Ciudad puede invertir hasta \$120,000 o el 20% en asistencia para el pago inicial. La propiedad debe estar ubicada dentro de los límites de la Ciudad. El solicitante debe ser un comprador de vivienda por primera vez que reside actualmente en Huntington Park y debe ocupar la propiedad como residencia principal.
