Through this project, state of the art fitness centers were provided to four schools: Gage, Nimitz, Huntington Park High School, & Marquez High School, and nutrition classes were offered to the community.

The City Council also recognized HP Post Office Employees (second picture top right corner) and Local Educators (fourth picture bottom right corner).


Finally, the City Council honored & celebrated the life of Mr. Juan Cerdá (third picture bottom left corner – son of Mr. Cerdá received the certificate). Mr. Cerdá was a devoted husband, father, grandfather who worked and lived in the City for the past 48 years. The City Council and the community extend their deepest sympathy on the passing of our beloved community member and celebrate his legacy of life memories.

El martes 17 de octubre de 2023, el Concejo Municipal entregó un certificado de reconocimiento al Programa Sound Body Sound Mind de UCLA (abajo arriba a la izquierda). En 2018, la organización recibió una subvención de \$300,000 de la Fundación Unihealth. El Sr. Cerdá fue un esposo, padre y abuelo que trabajó y vivió en la ciudad durante los últimos 48 años. El Concejo Municipal y la comunidad extienden sus más profundas condolencias por el fallecimiento de nuestro querido miembro de la comunidad y celebran su legado de vida.





Hispanic Heritage Month Honoring Jaime Jarrín

On Tuesday, October 17, 2023, the City Council presented a Proclamation recognizing and Honoring Mr. Jaime Jarrín.

Mr. Jaime Jarrín was born on December 10, 1935, in Cayambe, Ecuador. He began working as a broadcaster in Ecuador when he was just 16 years old; later becoming the announcer of the National Congress of Ecuador. Mr. Jarrín migrated to the United States on June 24, 1955, at the age of 20. He started working for the station KWKW-1300 AM as their News and Sports Director. In 1958 when the Dodgers moved to Los Angeles, they enlisted KWKW to be the team's Spanish Language flagship station. Mr. Jarrín knew nothing about baseball prior to his work with the Dodgers. In 1973 after 14 years with the Dodgers, Mr. Jarrín became the club's number one Spanish language broadcaster.

From 1962 to 1984 he never missed a game, calling close to 4,000 games over 22 seasons. The streak was broken only when he took charge of all the Spanish language radio coverage and production for the 1984 summer Olympics in Los Angeles. Mr. Jarrín has called more than 30 world championships boxing titles through the world for radio television station in Latin American. He has called 25 All-Star World games, 25 World Series; and in addition to his work with the Dodgers, he covered major news event for KWKW including the Chicano Moratorium in 1970, memorial services for President John F. Kennedy.

In 1998 he was honored by the National Association of Hispanic Journalist with their highest award and received a star on the Hollywood walk of fame; in 2002 he was inducted into the California Broadcaster Association Hall of Fame and in 2003 into the Hispanic Heritage Baseball Museum.

In 2019 he initiated the Jaime & Blanca Jarrín Foundation that since its inception has awarded thousands in scholarships to law and journalism students to fulfill the mission of empowering Latino students. Mr. Jaime Jarrín became the longest tenured active broadcaster in baseball on April 7, 2017, and on September 28, 2021, he announced his retirement after 64 years as a Dodger Broadcaster.

During National Hispanic Heritage month, we recognize Mr. Jaime Jarrín for his leadership and many contributions to our nation.

El martes 17 de octubre de 2023, el Cabildo de la Ciudad presentó una Proclamación reconociendo y Honrando al Sr. Jaime Jarrín.

El señor Jaime Jarrín nació el 10 de diciembre de 1935 en Cayambe, Ecuador. Comenzó a trabajar como locutor en Ecuador cuando apenas tenía 16 años; convirtiéndose luego en el locutor del Congreso Nacional del Ecuador. El señor Jarrín emigró a los Estados Unidos el 24 de junio de 1955, a la edad de 20 años. Ingresó a trabajar para la emisora KWKW-1300 AM como Director de Noticias y Deportes. En 1958, cuando los Dodgers se mudaron a Los Ángeles, reclutaron a KWKW para que fuera la estación insignia en español del equipo. Jarrín no sabía nada sobre béisbol antes de trabajar con los Dodgers. En 1973, después de 14 años con los Dodgers, Jarrín se convirtió en el locutor número uno en español del club.

De 1962 a 1984 nunca se perdió un partido, narrando cerca de 4.000 partidos en 22 temporadas. La racha sólo se rompió cuando se hizo cargo de toda la cobertura y producción de radio en español para los Juegos Olímpicos de verano de 1984 en Los Ángeles. El Sr. Jarrín ha convocado más de 30 títulos de campeonatos mundiales de boxeo en todo el mundo para estaciones de radio televisión en América Latina. Ha convocado 25 Juegos Mundiales de Estrellas, 25 Series Mundiales; y además de su trabajo con los Dodgers, cubrió eventos noticiosos importantes para KWKW, incluida la Moratoria Chicana en 1970, y los servicios conmemorativos del presidente John F. Kennedy.

En 1998 fue honrado por la Asociación Nacional de Periodistas Hispanos con su máximo galardón y recibió una estrella en el Paseo de la Fama de Hollywood; en 2002 fue incluido en el Salón de la Fama de la Asociación de Locutores de California y en 2003 en el Museo del Béisbol de la Herencia Hispana.

En 2019 inició la Fundación Jaime & Blanca Jarrín que desde sus inicios ha otorgado miles de becas a estudiantes de derecho y periodismo para cumplir con la misión de empoderar a los estudiantes latinos. El Sr. Jaime Jarrín se convirtió en el locutor activo con mayor antigüedad en el béisbol el 7 de abril de 2017, y el 28 de septiembre de 2021 anunció su retiro después de 64 años como locutor de los Dodgers.

Durante el Mes Nacional de la Herencia Hispana, reconocemos al Sr. Jaime Jarrín por su liderazgo y sus muchas contribuciones a nuestra nación.

Eco-Friendly Holiday Tips

As the holiday season approaches, consider incorporating these eco-friendly tips into your celebration. Let's make a difference for the planet!

Recycled or Eco-Friendly Packaging: Use recycled or biodegradable packaging materials for gifts and products.

Digital Greeting Cards: Send holiday greetings and messages digitally rather than printing paper cards. If physical cards are needed, use recycled paper.

Reduce Food Waste: Implement measures to reduce food waste during holiday events, such as careful planning, donation of surplus food, or composting.


