



Huntington Park 5th Annual 5K Easter Fun Run

ROBOCOP


The City of Huntington Park and the Huntington Park Police Department, re-introduce Robocop. The robot is a rolling egg-shaped equipped with 360-degree camera vision that can live-feed back to the department or record. This robot was announced back on June 18, 2019 and an update version is being introduced today as the newest member of the police department. The robot would patrol Salt Lake Park to provide as an extra layer of surveillance to the police department, this data could help lower crime rates, especially when the human police officers are not present.



ROBOCOP

La Ciudad de Huntington Park y el Departamento de Policía de Huntington Park reintroducen Robocop. El robot tiene forma de una elipse rodante y está equipado con una cámara de visión de 360 grados que puede transmitir información en vivo al departamento. Este robot fue anunciado el 18 de junio de 2019 y una versión nueva es presentada hoy como el miembro más nuevo del departamento de policía. El robot patrullara Salt Lake Park para proporcionar una capa adicional de vigilancia al departamento de policía. Con los datos recopilados se podría ayudar a reducir las tasas de criminalidad, especialmente cuando los policías no están presentes.
