
***Discussion and/or action on the status of new school development in the city of Huntington Park:***



Santana, Development Team Manager; Luis Ramirez, Senior Realty Agent; and Dan Kreinbring, Facilities Services Division.

LAUSD staff distributed a pamphlet to the Commissioners which illustrated new school construction projects at the following areas in the city of Huntington Park: 2660 East 57<sup>th</sup> Street, 6055 Corona Avenue, 2410 Zoe Avenue, 2855 Saturn Avenue, (project complete), 6720 Miles Avenue, 6222 State Street, Northeast corner of Alameda Street and Gage Avenue and 7560 State Street.

There were questions and comments from the Commissioners to the LAUSD staff regarding LAUSD's role in the removal of graffiti from school property, aesthetics, and the process for designing school logos, designating school structure colors, and naming of the schools. A discussion ensued. No action was taken on this item.
