



MANAGER CODE OF CONDUCT - ADULT SPORTS PROGRAM

I hereby pledge to live up to my responsibility as a team manager participating in the City of Huntington Park Department of Parks and Recreation Adult Sports Program. I will follow all rules and regulations.

Manager's Responsibility

1. A manager is responsible for his/her behavior, his/her team, player behavior, and team fans. When a player is ejected from a game, and the game official(s) feel that the manager is not attempting to control the individual, he will also be subject to ejection. All ejected players must immediately leave the premises.
2. The team manager is responsible for submitting umpire/referee fees prior to the start of every game (\$14 per team per game for softball and \$37 per team per game for basketball). Games will not begin until all umpires fees are paid in full.
3. Team managers cannot cancel games. If a team cannot make a game, the game will be considered a forfeit and the team must pay the forfeit fees.
4. The team manager shall see that the roster sheet is appropriately completed no later than the second league game.
5. The team manager will ensure that he/she will abide by any and all Recreation Department rules and regulations and hold his/her team accountable for abiding by them.
6. Players and coaches are not to argue, strike, intimidate or threaten any official scorekeeper, City of Huntington Park staff, opposing player, fan, or league volunteer. Doing so will result in an automatic suspension, that will be based on the severity of the incident. Any gang related threats will result in automatic expulsion from the league and reported to the Huntington Park Police Department.
7. Remember to be a good sport at all times, win or lose.
