Mayor Arturo Flores Steps Down from His Role as Mayor of the City of Huntington Park

HUNTINGTON PARK, CA – Effective January 13, 2026, Mayor Arturo Flores has resigned from his role as Mayor of the City of Huntington Park to focus on responding to an attempted recall of his City Council seat. He will continue to serve as a member of the City Council.

The resignation applies solely to the ceremonial role of Mayor and does not affect City governance, operations, or service delivery. Day-to-day operations at City Hall remain unchanged.

In accordance with City procedures, Vice Mayor Eddie Martinez will assume the duties of Mayor on an interim basis. The City Council will consider the selection of a new Mayor at its next regularly scheduled meeting on January 27, 2026.

Further details regarding the resignation should be directed to Councilmember Arturo Flores.

City staff will continue to carry out all municipal functions without interruption.
