City of Huntington Park Announces Selection of Mayor and Vice Mayor

HUNTINGTON PARK, Calif. — The Huntington Park City Council has selected Eduardo “Eddie” Martínez to serve as Mayor and Jonathan A. Sanabria to serve as Vice Mayor for a one-year term following the Council’s reorganization on Tuesday, January 27, 2026.
