DEFINITION

Semi-skilled worker who performs a variety of duties related to the maintenance of streets, parks, electrical systems facilities which include the repair, restoration, construction, reconstruction, cleaning, grounds keeping, and general rubbish collection service; performs other related duties as required.

EXAMPLE OF DUTIES

Performs repair and maintenance to streets, sidewalks, parkways, sewers, park grounds and building maintenance; to include but not limited to weed, move, cultivate, trim, edge, water spray, clean, prepare, and paint benches, equipment, sign posts, refuse receptacles, etc; removes, repairs, restores or installs signs, posts, rock or rock products, portland cement, asphalt concrete or similar products used in the maintenance of streets; sweeps, cleans, picks up, collects, and disposes of cans, paper, bottles and other debris, performs elementary adjustments and preventative maintenance to hand tools and light equipment.

EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS

Education and Experience:

Graduation from high school or its academic equivalent and at least one (1) year of gardening, street work, or semi-skilled labor experience.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

Knowledge of methods, materials, and equipment used in maintenance of streets, parks, electrical systems or facilities; skill to use various tools and equipment; ability to work with a minimum of supervision; ability to follow written and oral instruction; and the ability to maintain a cooperative working relationship.

Special Requirements:

A General Laborer must be able to work evenings and weekends.

License:

A valid California class "3" driver's license.
