Question: Where is the animal shelter located?

Pregunta: Donde esta localizado el refugio de animales?

Answer: L.A. County Shelter # 1 **Low Cost Vaccinations**

Question: What should I do if my dog dies?

Answer: Call your local animal control agency to have it picked up or take it to the animal shelter that services your area.

(Huntington Park residents, please refer to the shelter listed above)

Pregunta: A donde puedo llamar si mi perro muere?

Respuesta: Favor de llamar al servicio de control de animales de su area o lleve el cadaver de su mascota al refugio de animales mas cercano a usted.

Question: If I can no longer keep my pet(s) where can I take them?

Answer: You can take them to the Animal Shelter

(Open 24 hours 7 days a week FOR RECEIVING ANIMALS ONLY)

The shelter has specific hours for other services such as adoptions, vaccination etc.

Pregunta: Si ya no puedo mantener a mi mascota a donde la puedo entregar?

Respuesta: Puede llevarla al refugio de animales

Question: Who do I call if there is a live or dead animal on the street?

Answer: Call your local animal control agency and request assistance.

Pregunta: A donde puedo llamar si veo un perro perdido en la calle o un animal muerto?

Respuesta: Favor de llamar al servicio de control de animales de su area.

Question: Where can I get a license for my dog? (Current rabies vaccine certificate and microchip required)

Pregunta: Donde puedo obtener la licencia para mi perro? (vacuna de la rabia y microchip son requeridos)

Answer: Huntington Park City Hall **(Huntington Park Residents Only)**

Question: Can I walk my dog off a leash?

Answer: No, leashes are required by law. (Must not be longer than 6 feet).
(\$100 fine for this violation)

Question: Can I allow my dog to run loose if he has a current license?

Answer: No, dogs are not allowed to run loose with or without a license.
(\$100 minimum fine for this violation)

Pregunta: Puedo dejar a mi perro suelto en la calle?

Respuesta: No, aun con licencia los perros deben estar atados de un laso y correa (6 pies de largo maximo)

Question: Can I take my dog inside restaurants?

Answer: No, dogs are not allowed in food establishments (except guide dogs for the blind)

Pregunta: Puedo llevar mi perro al parque o a un restaurante ?

Respuesta: No, no son permitidos los perros en los parques y restaurantes.

Question: Where can I adopt animals from? **Pregunta:** Donde Puedo adoptar animales?

Answer: At your local animal shelter. **Respuesta:** En el refugio de animales de su area

Question: Can I keep chickens, roosters, goats, ducks, geese, or pigs as pets in Huntington Park?

Answer: No, none of the animals above are allowed in Huntington Park.

Pregunta: Puedo mantener gallos, gallinas, patos, Cerdos, Chivos, Borregos etc. en mi casa?

Respuesta: No, estos animales no son permitidos en la Ciudad de Huntington Park

Question: How many animals can I keep at my house?

(The information below applies to City of Huntington Park Residents only)

Answer: Single family residence (one house on the lot): 3 dogs & 3 cats

Multi Family Properties (condominiums apartments etc): 1 dog & 1 cat per unit

Duplex (two separate houses on the lot): 2 dogs & 2 cats for each unit

Pregunta: Cuantos perros estan permitidos por vivienda?

Respuesta: Una casa en el lote: 3 perros y 3 Gatos maximo

Un condominio u Apartamento: 1 perro y 1 gato maximo

Un duplex (dos casas en un lote): 2 perros y dos gatos por casa maximo

Adopting from animal shelters and rescue groups.

From animal shelters usually a fastest process, however do consider all of the following regardless of where you choose to adopt from.

Things to consider when adopting animals:

1. Time. (Pets require a reasonable amount of time for caring and training)
2. Your Budget \$\$\$ (food, veterinarian costs, grooming, dog License fees etc.)
3. Space. Check your fence. Is your yard big and secure enough for your future pet?
4. Does your landlord allow pets on the property?

Different breeds have different needs. Consider the following:

- Grooming needs /costs. Grooming can cost from \$40 and up, depending on the size of your pet.
- Veterinarian costs: Pure bred dogs potentially have higher veterinarian costs in the long run opposed to mixed breeds. (Due to genetic overlapping)
- Do not adopt a dog based on looks. A lot of dogs end up back at the shelter for choosing the wrong dog. Adopting a pet is like matching pieces on a puzzle, they both have to fit just right.
- Family size. Will there be children in the home with the dog/cat?
- Are there other dogs or pets in the home? Will they get along? Must learn to introduce pets gradually as they can be territorial when bringing a new pet into the home.
- It is a family affair, everyone should be involved in some way with the pet adopted.
- Don't breed your dog, instead adopt from animal shelters and give a homeless pet a chance.

Better to adopt than to buy

1. Lower costs, plus help relieve overcrowded animal shelters.
2. Spayed / Neutered, microchipped and vaccinated. (Lower upfront costs)
